The meeting opened with the flag pledge at 7:30 p.m.

1. **Roll call** of the board. Present: Rentschler, Lindemann, Staebler, Canham, Godek, Foley and Masters. Also present Attorney O'Jack, John Steeb, Planning Commission Chair and 3 citizens.
2. **Consent Agenda.** Moved Lindemann, seconded Staebler to approve the Consent Agenda. Carried.
 - C-1: May Regular meeting minutes.
 - C-2: Approve Investment Report
 - C-3: Payment of Bills May 12 through June 1, 2010.
 - C-4: Recognize Zoning Report
3. **Attorney** - Peters Summit filed to reopen their case three years ago. The court has not sent anything out. We need to file documents with the court to get the case off the books.
4. **Sheriff** - Sgt. Archer reported on happenings within the township through June 1. Lodi has had 258 calls year to date compared to last year at this time of 294 calls. Sgt. Archer will be leaving his position in Manchester going to the sheriff office. Interviews will be held to fill his position.
5. **Public Comment offered at 7:39 p.m.**
6. **Revise Agenda** – Moved Foley seconded Masters to approve the agenda adding cemetery filming under new business. Carried.
7. **Unfinished Business** -
 - a. **Cemetery Columbarium Contract - Jerry Diuble** - Estimate for building the columbaria at Lodi Cemetery is \$6,687.00. Moved Masters, second Canham to approve the estimate for complete construction of the columbarium project at Lodi Cemetery. Funds to be taken from the cemetery fund money donated by John Steeb. Carried.
8. **New Business**
 - a. **Lodi Township Cemetery - Filming at the Cemetery** - Shelley Wilson from Spehar Productions is requesting the ability to film a scene at Lodi Cemetery. It would involve one day for three to five hours and have less than ten people. Will probably be doing the filming in the next two to three weeks. It is a no budget film, credits will include Lodi Township. Moved Masters, seconded Lindemann to authorize the filming at the cemetery with the maximum number of people being 10, any damage would be their responsibility to repair. Title of the film is "Flowers for Katie". The movie will be on the internet. A fake headstone will be used for the filming. Carried.

- b. Fire Run bill for 4019 Saline Waterworks Road** - A fire run resulted when a company tried to solve a sewer drainage problem. About 10 years ago DTE put a gas line into the house on 4019 Saline Waterworks Road. Unbeknown to DTE or the home owner when the gas line was put in they drilled through the sewer pipe. Over the years the sewer worked, but it began causing problems last winter, hence the gas line was broken when attempting to clear the sewer line. The board discussion included sending a letter to DTE with a copy of Ordinance 2000-001, stating that the bill falls under the hazardous material ordinance.
